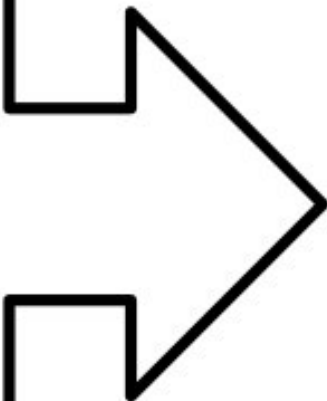

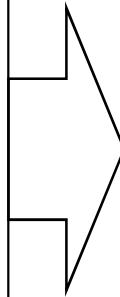

Cause

The Columbian Exchange is the movement of plants animals and people between Afro-Eurasia (Old World) and the Americas (New World). Tomatoes, corn, and potatoes came from the Americas and wheat, as well as, animals like horses and cattle came from Afro-Eurasia.
